FRIENDSHIP WAGON

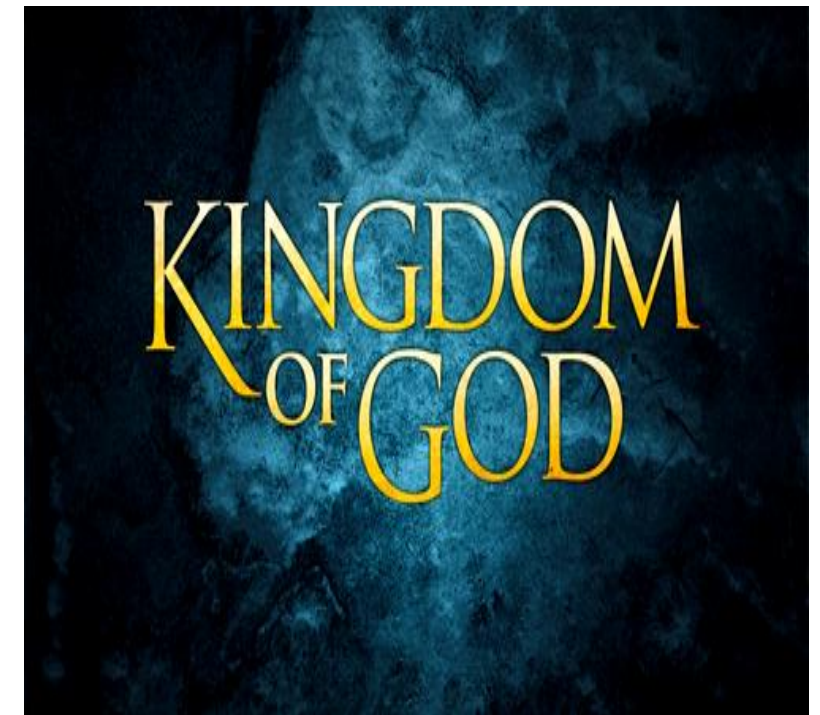
